## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 35. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military
- 18 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for
- 19 the payment of benefits authorized under the Survivor's
- 20 Compensation Act.
- 21 Section 40. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
