Appropriates \$25,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Capital Development Board for grants for architectural and engineering studies and construction of a cooperative high school in Vermilion County involving Jamaica High School, Oakwood High School, and Catlin High School. 2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$25,000,000, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
6 Revenue Fund to the Capital Development Board for grants for  
7 architectural and engineering studies and construction of a  
8 cooperative high school in Vermilion County involving Jamaica  
9 High School, Oakwood High School, and Catlin High School.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
11 2009.
