2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 5

13 Section 5-15. The amount of \$1,587,400, or as much of  
 14 that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State  
 15 Board of Elections from the General Revenue Fund for  
 16 redevelopment and replacement of IDIS campaign disclosure and  
 17 reporting application to reflect currently supportable  
 18 technology (001-58710-1900-06-00).

19 Section 5-20. The amount of \$1,500,000, or as much of  
 20 that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State  
 21 Board of Elections from the State Board of Elections Federal  
 22 Trust Fund for data collection project activities, under the  
 23 federal EAC Data Collection Grant, related to the November

1 2008 federal election (647-58710-4900-00-55) (spending  
2 authority only).
