

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 HB4584

Introduced , by Rep. Chapin Rose

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Provides that, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary: (1) the amounts appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Redeploy Illinois and for costs associated with William A. Howe Developmental Center for FY2010 is \$0; (2) the amount appropriated to the Department of Agriculture for the University of Illinois Cook County Cooperative Extension Service for FY2010 is \$0; and (3) the amount appropriated to the Department of Human Services for costs associated with certain Community Based Services and Programs for FY2010 is increased by \$75,000,000. Effective July 1, 2009.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the amount appropriated to the Department of Human Services, payable from the General Revenue Fund, for Redeploy Illinois for the State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 is \$0.
- Notwithstanding any other 9 10. law to contrary, the amount appropriated to the Department of Human 10 Services, payable from the General Revenue Fund, for costs 11 12 associated with the operation of William Α. Howe Developmental Center or the transition of William A. Howe 13 Developmental Center services to alternative community or 14 State-operated settings for the State fiscal year beginning 15 July 1, 2009 is \$0. 16
- 17 Section 15. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the amount appropriated from the General Revenue 18 Fund to the Department of Agriculture for deposit into the 19 20 Cooperative Extension Service Trust Fund for 21 operational expenses and programs at the University of

- 2 State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 is \$0.
- Notwithstanding any other law to 3 Section 20. contrary, in addition to any other amounts appropriated to 4 5 the Department of Human Services, payable from the General Revenue Fund, for Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its 6 various regions pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community 7 Services Act and the Community Mental Health Act for all 8 9 costs associated with Community Based Services for Persons 10 With Developmental Disabilities and for Intermediate Care for the Mentally Retarded and 11 Facilities Alternative 12 Community Programs, including prior year costs, for the State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, the sum of \$75,000,000 is 13 appropriated for that purpose. 14
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
