#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Provides that, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary: (1) the amounts appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Redeploy Illinois and for costs associated with William A. Howe Developmental Center for FY2010 is \$0; (2) the amount appropriated to the Department of Agriculture for the University of Illinois Cook County Cooperative Extension Service for FY2010 is \$0; and (3) the amount appropriated to the Department of Human Services for costs associated with certain Community Based Services and Programs for FY2010 is increased by \$75,000,000. Effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. Notwithstanding any other law to the  
5 contrary, the amount appropriated to the Department of Human  
6 Services, payable from the General Revenue Fund, for Redeploy  
7 Illinois for the State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 is  
8 \$0.

9 Section 10. Notwithstanding any other law to the  
10 contrary, the amount appropriated to the Department of Human  
11 Services, payable from the General Revenue Fund, for costs  
12 associated with the operation of William A. Howe  
13 Developmental Center or the transition of William A. Howe  
14 Developmental Center services to alternative community or  
15 State-operated settings for the State fiscal year beginning  
16 July 1, 2009 is \$0.

17 Section 15. Notwithstanding any other law to the  
18 contrary, the amount appropriated from the General Revenue  
19 Fund to the Department of Agriculture for deposit into the  
20 State Cooperative Extension Service Trust Fund for  
21 operational expenses and programs at the University of

1 Illinois Cook County Cooperative Extension Service for the  
2 State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 is \$0.

3 Section 20. Notwithstanding any other law to the  
4 contrary, in addition to any other amounts appropriated to  
5 the Department of Human Services, payable from the General  
6 Revenue Fund, for Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its  
7 various regions pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community  
8 Services Act and the Community Mental Health Act for all  
9 costs associated with Community Based Services for Persons  
10 With Developmental Disabilities and for Intermediate Care  
11 Facilities for the Mentally Retarded and Alternative  
12 Community Programs, including prior year costs, for the State  
13 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, the sum of \$75,000,000 is  
14 appropriated for that purpose.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
16 2009.
