SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/143e new

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Requires all companies issuing policies of automobile insurance to provide to a policyholder who submits certification of the completion of a course in the installation of a child restraint system a discount in the amount of 5% of the premium charges for the 6 months following receipt of the certification. Effective immediately.

- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 143e as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/143e new)
- 7 Sec. 143e. Automobile insurance; discount for child
- 8 restraint system installation course. All companies issuing
- 9 policies of automobile insurance, as defined in Section 143.13
- of this Code, shall provide to a policyholder who submits
- 11 certification of the completion of a course in the installation
- of a child restraint system, as defined in the Child Passenger
- 13 Protection Act, a discount in the amount of 5% of the premium
- 14 charges for the 6 months following receipt of the
- 15 <u>certification</u>.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 17 becoming law.
