## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Child Passenger Protection Act is amended by changing Section 6 and by adding Section 6a as follows:

- 8 <u>(a)</u> A <u>first</u> violation of this Act is a petty offense 9 punishable by a fine of \$100.
- 10 (b) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this Section, a person charged with a violation of Section 4 of this Act shall 11 12 not be convicted if the person produces in court satisfactory evidence not more than \$50 waived upon proof of possession of 13 14 an approved child restraint system, as defined under this Act, and proof of completion of a Child Passenger Safety 15 16 <u>Certification (CPSC) instructional course on the installation</u> 17 of a child restraint system pursuant to Section 6a of this Act. The chief judge of each circuit may designate an officer of the 18 19 court to review the documentation demonstrating that a person charged with a violation of Section 4 of this Act is in 20 21 possession of an approved child restraint system and has 22 completed a Child Passenger Safety Certification (CPSC)
- 23 <u>instructional course</u>.

- 1 (c) A second or subsequent violation of this Act is a petty
- 2 offense punishable by a fine of \$500 not more than \$100.
- 3 (d) Subsection (b) of this Section shall not apply in the

- 10 (a) As used in this Section, "technician" means a person
- 11 who has successfully completed the U.S. Department of

- 15 current child passenger safety technician or technician
- 16 instructor certification through the current certifying body

- (b) A person in violation of Section 4 of this Act may 19

9	(e) Upon completion of the CPSC instructional course to the
10	satisfaction of the technician conducting the inspection, a
11	letter shall be issued to the person for presentation in court.

14	(2) indicate that the person has voluntarily
15	participated in the CPSC instructional course and received
16	instruction from a technician regarding the proper use of

21	issued, and (iv) the technician's signature and technician

23	(f) Upon completion of the inspection and instruction, the
24	technician shall issue a copy of the CPSC participation letter
