2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 4805 on page 2, by
3	replacing line 6 through line 15 with the following:
4	"Any civil penalties collected in a court proceeding shall
5	be deposited into:
6	$\underline{\text{(1)}}$ the $\frac{1}{2}$ delegated county lead poisoning screening,
7	prevention, and abatement fund of the delegate agency
8	conducting the environmental investigation; or,
9	(2) the lead poisoning screening, prevention, and
10	abatement fund maintained by the delegate agency
11	conducting the environmental investigation that has
12	jurisdiction where the violation occurred.
13	If if no delegated county or delegate agency lead poisoning
14	screening, prevention, and abatement fund exists, then any
15	civil penalties collected in a court proceeding shall be
16	deposited into the Lead Poisoning Screening, Prevention, and
17	Abatement Fund established under Section 7.2.".
