Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Deletes language requiring the payment of fees, in addition to the to the applicable registration fee, for Korean War Veteran, U.S. Veteran, Vietnam Veteran, World War II Veteran, Army Combat Veteran, and U.S. Army Veteran special license plates.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Sections 3-626, 3-638, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, and 3-680 as
follows:

7 (625 ILCS 5/3-626)

8 Sec. 3-626. Korean War Veteran license plates.

9 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 10 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 11 issue special registration plates designated as Korean War 12 13 Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois who 14 participated in the United States Armed Forces during the Korean War. The special plate issued under this Section shall 15 16 be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 17 motorcycles, motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by 18 19 Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section 20 shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure 21 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall bewholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The

Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 1 2 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 3 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 4 5 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall 6 approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under 7 Section 3-412. 8

9 (c) <u>(Blank)</u>. An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for 10 original issuance in addition to the applicable registration 11 fee. Of this additional fee, \$13 shall be deposited into the 12 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$2 shall be 13 deposited into the Korean War Memorial Construction Fund.

(d) The Korean War Memorial Construction Fund is created as 14 15 a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Korean 16 War Memorial Construction Fund shall, subject to 17 appropriation, be used by the Department of Veteran Affairs to provide grants for construction of the Korean War Memorial to 18 19 be located at Oak Ridge Cemetery in Springfield, Illinois. Upon 20 the completion of the Memorial, the Department of Veteran 21 Affairs shall certify to the State Treasurer that the 22 construction of the Memorial has been completed. Upon the 23 certification by the Department of Veteran Affairs, the State Treasurer shall transfer all moneys in the Fund and any future 24 25 deposits into the Fund into the Secretary of State Special 26 License Plate Fund.

(e) An individual who has been issued Korean War Veteran 1 2 license plates for a vehicle and who has been approved for benefits under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons 3 Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act shall pay 4 5 the original issuance and the regular annual fee for the registration of the vehicle as provided in Section 3-806.3 of 6 7 this Code in addition to the fees specified in subsection (c) 8 of this Section.

12 Sec. 3-638. U.S. Veteran License Plates.

13 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 14 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 15 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 16 issue U.S. Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of 17 State. The special U.S. Veteran plate issued under this Section 18 shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first 19 20 division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 21 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 22 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 23 24 Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be

wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 1 2 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 3 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 4 5 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 6 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the 7 eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall 8 approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under 9 Section 3-412.

(c) (Blank). An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 17 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 18 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 19 issue Vietnam Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois 20 21 who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary 22 of State. The special Vietnam Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 23 24 first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 25

1 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered 2 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 3 Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 4 5 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 6 7 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 8 9 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 10 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the 11 eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall 12 approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under 13 Section 3-412.

(c) (Blank). An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications
made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may
issue World War II Veteran license plates to residents of
Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the

Secretary of State. The special World War II Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

8 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 9 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 10 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 11 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with 12 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 13 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the 14 eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall 15 16 approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under 17 Section 3-412.

18 (c) <u>(Blank)</u>. An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for 19 original issuance in addition to the applicable registration 20 fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary 21 of State Special License Plate Fund.

25 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the

Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 1 2 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Army Combat Veteran license plates to residents of 3 Illinois who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the 4 5 Secretary of State. The special Army Combat Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger 6 vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles 7 8 of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. 9 Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the 10 staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 11 of this Code.

12 (b) The plates shall display the Army Combat Infantry 13 Badge. In all other respects, the design, color, and format of the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary of 14 State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the 15 16 plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in 17 accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in 18 subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary 19 20 shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her 21 discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412. 22

(c) (Blank). An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for
 original issuance in addition to the applicable registration
 fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary
 of State Special License Plate Fund.

5 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 6 7 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 8 issue U.S. Army Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois 9 who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary 10 of State. The special U.S. Army Veteran plate issued under this 11 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 12 first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 13 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered 14 15 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 16 Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 17 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 18 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 19 20 issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with 21 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 22 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. 2 (c) (Blank). An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for 3 original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary 4 of State Special License Plate Fund.
