All fees collected under this Act shall be paid into the Road Fund of the State treasury, except that the following amounts shall be paid into the General Revenue Fund: (i) 80% of the fee for an original, renewal, or duplicate Illinois Identification Card issued on or after January 1, 2005; and (ii) 80% of the fee for a corrected Illinois Identification Card issued on or after January 1, 2005.

Any disabled person making an application for a standard Illinois Identification Card for no fee must, along with the application, submit an affirmation by the applicant on a form to be provided by the Secretary of State, attesting that such person is a disabled person as defined in Section 4A of this Act.

14 An individual, who resides in a veterans home or veterans 15 hospital operated by the state or federal government, who makes 16 an application for an Illinois Identification Card to be issued at no fee, must submit, along with the application, an 17 18 affirmation by the applicant on a form provided by the Secretary of State, that such person resides in a veterans home 19 20 or veterans hospital operated by the state or federal 21 government.

Any disabled person making an application for a standard Illinois Identification Card for no fee must, along with the application, submit an affirmation by the applicant on a form to be provided by the Secretary of State, attesting that such person is a disabled person as defined in Section 4A of this Act.

7 An individual, who resides in a veterans home or veterans 8 hospital operated by the state or federal government, who makes 9 an application for an Illinois Identification Card to be issued 10 at no fee, must submit, along with the application, an 11 affirmation by the applicant on a form provided by the Secretary of State, that such person resides in a veterans home 12 or veterans hospital operated by the state or federal 13 14 government.

15 The application of a homeless individual for an Illinois 16 Identification Card to be issued at no fee must be accompanied 17 by an affirmation by a qualified person, as defined in Section 18 4C of this Act, on a form provided by the Secretary of State, 19 that the applicant is currently homeless as defined in Section 20 1A of this Act.

If an indigent military veteran makes a written request or application for an identification card and that veteran provides documentation certified by a County Veterans Assistance Commission verifying his or her status as an indigent veteran, then the indigent military veteran shall not be charged any fee for such request or application.
