

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Sex Offense Victim Polygraph Act is amended  
5 by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 200/1) (from Ch. 38, par. 1551)

7 Sec. 1. Lie Detector Tests. (a) No law enforcement officer,  
8 State's Attorney or other official shall ask or require an  
9 alleged victim of an offense described in Sections 12-13  
10 through 12-16 of the Criminal Code of 1961, as amended, to  
11 submit to a polygraph examination or any form of a mechanical  
12 or electrical lie detector test ~~as a condition for proceeding~~  
13 ~~with the investigation, charging or prosecution of such~~  
14 ~~offense, and such test shall be administered to such victim~~  
15 ~~solely at the victim's request.~~

16 (b) A victim's refusal to submit to a polygraph or any form  
17 of a mechanical or electrical lie detector test shall not  
18 mitigate against the investigation, charging or prosecution of  
19 the pending case as originally charged.
