## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/10-160

Amends the Property Tax Code. Provides that applications for open space valuation must be filed by June 30 (instead of January 31). Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
Section 10-160 as follows:

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(35 ILCS 200/10-160)

7 Sec. 10-160. Open space; application process. For taxable 8 years prior to 2010, the The person liable for taxes on land 9 used for open space purposes must file a verified application requesting the additional open space valuation with the chief 10 county assessment officer by January 31 of each year for which 11 that valuation is desired. 12 For taxable year 2010 and 13 thereafter, the person liable for taxes on land used for open 14 space purposes must file a verified application requesting the additional open space valuation with the chief county 15 16 assessment officer by June 30 of each year for which that 17 valuation is desired. If the application is not filed by January 31 (for taxable years prior to 2010) or June 30 (for 18 19 taxable year 2010 and thereafter), the taxpayer waives the 20 right to claim that additional valuation for that year. The 21 application shall be in the form prescribed by the Department 22 and contain information as may reasonably be required to determine whether the applicant meets the requirements of 23

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1 Section 10-155. If the application shows the applicant is 2 entitled to the valuation, the chief county assessment officer shall approve it; otherwise, the application shall be rejected. 3 4 When such an application has been filed with and approved 5 by the chief county assessment officer, he or she shall 6 determine the valuation of the land as otherwise permitted by 7 law and as required under Section 10-155, and shall list those 8 valuations separately. The county clerk, in preparing 9 assessment books, lists and blanks under Section 9-100, shall 10 include therein columns for indicating the approval of an 11 application and for setting out the two separate valuations. 12 (Source: P.A. 80-1364; 88-455.)

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
