HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives are pleased to thank the workers of Waste
4 Management Inc. in Elgin for their hard work and diligence in
5 saving Old Glory from the trash; and

7 facility work together to pull flags from the trash; the idea
