1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2	WHEREAS, Each year sudden cardiac arrest claims the lives
3	of more than 250,000 Americans before they reach a hospital; it
4	strikes people of all levels of fitness, and it usually strikes
5	without warning; and

- WHEREAS, Most often, sudden cardiac arrest is caused by an abnormal heart rhythm called ventricular fibrillation that prevents the heart from pumping blood; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The treatment for ventricular fibrillation is 10 defibrillation, which is the delivery of an electric shock to 11 the heart that stops ventricular fibrillation and allows a 12 normal heart rhythm to resume; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Providing defibrillation on-site with an
 14 Automated External Defibrillator (AED) can significantly
 15 increase survival rates for ventricular fibrillation cardiac
 16 arrest; and
- WHEREAS, The American Heart Association is a national voluntary health agency whose mission is to reduce disability and death from cardiovascular diseases and stroke, and it is dedicated to helping businesses and communities establish on-site AED programs; and
