Amends the Recyclable Metal Purchase Registration Law. Provides that iron, steel, and other ferrous metals are included in the definition of "recyclable metal". Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning business.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Recyclable Metal Purchase Registration Law
is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 325/2) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 322)

7 Sec. 2. Definitions. When used in this Act:

"Recyclable metal" means any copper, brass, or aluminum, 8 9 iron, steel, or any other ferrous metal, or any combination of those metals, purchased by a recyclable metal 10 dealer, irrespective of form or quantity, except that "recyclable 11 metal" does not include: (i) items designed to contain, or to 12 be used in the preparation of, beverages or food for human 13 14 consumption; (ii) discarded items of non-commercial or household waste; (iii) gold, silver, platinum, and other 15 16 precious metals used in jewelry; or (iv) vehicles, junk 17 vehicles, vehicle cowls, or essential vehicle parts.

"Recyclable metal dealer" means any individual, firm, 18 19 corporation or partnership engaged in the business of reselling recyclable metal 20 purchasing and either at а 21 permanently established place of business or in connection with 22 a business of an itinerant nature, including junk shops, junk yards, or junk stores, except that "recyclable metal dealer" 23

does not include automotive parts recyclers, scrap processors, repairers and rebuilders licensed pursuant to Section 5-301 of the Illinois Vehicle Code. Recyclable metal dealers shall not be engaged in the business of purchasing or reselling vehicles, junk vehicles, vehicle cowls, or essential vehicle parts.
