  - (4) the facility's assessment, care planning, and implementation guidelines in the care and treatment of persons with Alzheimer's disease;
  - the facility's minimum and maximum (5) staffing ratios, specifying the general licensed health care provider to client ratio and the trainee health care provider to client ratio;
    - (6) the facility's physical environment;
  - (7) activities available to clients at the facility;

- (9) the costs of care and treatment under the program 21 22 or at the center.
