AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5	Section 5. "Operational expenses" defined. For the
6	purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96 th General Assembly,
7	the term "operational expenses" includes the following items:

19	(j) Telecommunications services;
20	(k) Operation of automotive equipment;

21 (l) Refunds.

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1 Section 10. "Professional and artistic services" defined. 2 For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General 3 Assembly, the term "professional and artistic services" means 4 those services provided under contract to a State agency by a 5 person or business, acting as an independent contractor, 6 qualified by education, experience, and technical ability.

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ARTICLE 2

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 8 9 the amount of \$371,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 10 the Legislative Information System for operational expenses, 11 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 12 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 13 14 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or out of this line item. 15

ARTICLE 3

17 Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 18 the amount of \$36,485,500, or so much thereof as may be 19 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 20 the Supreme Court for operational expenses, awards, grants, 21 and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June SB1197 Enrolled -3- SDS096 00036 BAS 10b b 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 4

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 5 the amount of \$407,200, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 7 8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender for operational 9 expenses, awards, grants, state matching grant purposes, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 10 11 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or 12 out of this line item. 13

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ARTICLE 5

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, the amount of \$1,993,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor for operational expenses, awards, grants, state matching grant purposes, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended SB1197 Enrolled -4- SDS096 00036 BAS 10b b 1 for professional and artistic services. No money may be 2 transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 6

Section 25. 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1 the amount of \$1,887,500, or so much thereof as may be 2 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 3 the Office of the Attorney General for operational expenses, 4 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 5 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 6 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 7 be transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 8

9 Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, the amount of \$15,667,800, or so much thereof as may be 10 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 11 the Office of the Secretary of State for operational 12 expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the 13 14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money 15 16 may be transferred into or out of this line item.

17 Section 30. The amount of \$130,500,000, or so much 18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 19 Revenue Fund to the Secretary of State for the purpose of 20 replacing spending previously appropriated from the Road 21 Fund.

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ARTICLE 9

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 2 the amount of \$8,500,000, or so much thereof as may be 3 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 4 5 the Office of the State Treasurer for operational expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 6 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 7 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 8 be transferred into or out of this line item. 9

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ARTICLE 10

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 11 the amount of \$6,130,700, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to State Board of Elections for operational expenses, 14 the 15 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 16 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 17 18 be transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 11

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated,

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the amount of \$306,473,400, or so much thereof as may be 1 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 2 the Department on Aging for operational expenses, awards, 3 grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending 4 June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for 5 6 professional and artistic services. No money mav be transferred into or out of this line item. 7

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ARTICLE 12

9 Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, the amount of \$9,337,300, or so much thereof as may be 10 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 11 the Department of Agriculture for operational expenses, 12 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 13 14 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 15 16 be transferred into or out of this line item.

ARTICLE 13

18 Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 19 the amount of \$8,425,500, or so much thereof as may be 20 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 21 the Central Management Services for operational expenses, SB1197 Enrolled -8- SDS096 00036 BAS 10b b awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 14

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 6 the amount of \$314,331,900, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 8 9 the Department of Children and Family Services for expenses, awards, 10 operational grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except 11 that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic 12 services. No money may be transferred into or out of this 13 14 line item.

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ARTICLE 15

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 16 17 the amount of \$18,503,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 18 the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for 19 expenses, grants, 20 operational awards, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except 21

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ARTICLE 16

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 5 the amount of \$1,173,400, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 7 the Department of Natural Resources for operational expenses, 8 9 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 10 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 11 be transferred into or out of this line item. 12

No money may 8 be transferred into or out of this line item. 9

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ARTICLE 19

In addition to other amounts appropriated, 11 12 the amount of \$1,337,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 13 14 the Department of Human Rights for operational expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 15 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 16 17 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or out of this line item. 18

No money may be transferred into or out of this line item. 17

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ARTICLE 22

No money may be 5 transferred into or out of this line item.

In addition to other amounts appropriated, 7 8 the amount of \$1,128,700, or so much thereof as may be 9 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for operational expenses, 10 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 11 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 12 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 13 14 be transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 24

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 16 17 the amount of \$1,979,752,900, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 18 Department of Healthcare and Family Services 19 the for expenses, grants, 20 operational awards, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except 21

SB1197 Enrolled -13- SDS096 00036 BAS 10b b that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or out of this line item.

4 Section 30. For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 5 2009, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, with 6 the consent in writing from the Governor, may reapportion not 7 more than 4% of the total General Revenue Fund appropriations 8 to the Department for Medical Assistance, as contained in any 9 Act of the 96th General Assembly, among the various purposes 10 therein enumerated.

No money may be transferred into or out of this line item. 17

18 Section 30. The amount of \$105,584,500, or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 20 Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Police for the purpose of 21 replacing spending previously appropriated from the Road 22 Fund.

ARTICLE 28

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 2 the amount of \$33,141,600, or so much thereof as may be 3 4 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Transportation for operational expenses, 5 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 6 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 7 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 8 be transferred into or out of this line item. 9

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ARTICLE 29

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 11 12 the amount of \$1,990,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 13 14 the Department of Veterans' Affairs for operational expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 15 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be 16 17 expended for professional and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or out of this line item. 18

ARTICLE 30

In addition to other amounts appropriated, 7 8 the amount of \$3,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 9 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the State Universities Civil Service System for operational expenses, 10 11 awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 12 year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional and artistic services. No money may 13 14 be transferred into or out of this line item.

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ARTICLE 45

16 Section 5. The sum of \$8,540,000, or so much thereof as 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 18 Fund to the Court of Claims for payment of Line of Duty 19 Awards.

ARTICLE 46

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Section 5. The amount of \$1,900,000, or so much thereof 1 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of 2 Healthcare and Family Services from the General Revenue Fund 3 for the purpose of paying legal fees in the settlement of 4 5 Caro, et al. v. Blagojevich, et al., and the related appeals thereof, pursuant to the terms of any Settlement Agreement 6 entered into by the Department with the approval of the 7 Attorney General or ordered by the Court. 8

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ARTICLE 47

10 Section 5. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public 11 Act 95-734, approved July 9, 2008, as amended, is amended by 12 repealing Section 12 and changing Sections 10, 11, 13 and 14 13 to Article 7 as follows:
