SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 37/30

Amends the Environmental Health Practitioner Licensing Act. Requires the Department of Professional Regulation to issue a license as a licensed environmental health practitioner to any applicant who holds a Registered Environmental Health Specialist/Registered Sanitarian credential in good standing with the National Environmental Health Association. Effective July 1, 2009.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Environmental Health Practitioner Licensing
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 30 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 37/30)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2019)
- 8 Sec. 30. Endorsement. The Department may issue a license as
- 9 a licensed environmental health practitioner, without the
- 10 required examination, to an applicant licensed under the laws
- of another state if the requirements for licensure in that
- 12 state are, on the date of granting the license, substantially
- equal to the requirements of this Act. The Department shall
- 14 issue a license as a licensed environmental health practitioner
- to any applicant who holds a Registered Environmental Health
- 16 <u>Specialist/Registered Sanitarian credential in good standing</u>
- 17 with the National Environmental Health Association. An
- 18 applicant under this Section shall pay all required fees.
- 19 Applicants have 3 years from the date of application to
- 20 complete the application process. If the process has not been
- 21 completed within 3 years, the application shall be denied, the
- 22 fee forfeited, and the applicant must reapply and meet the
- requirements in effect at the time of reapplication.
