AN ACT concerning vehicle identification.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
Section 11-40-4 as follows:

(65 ILCS 5/11-40-4 new) 6 7 Sec. 11-40-4. American-made vehicles. A municipality shall require that all vehicles purchased or leased on or after the 8 9 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly for use by the municipality have a Vehicle 10 Identification Number that begins with the number one, the 11 number 4, or the number 5. A municipality may not regulate the 12 purchase or lease of vehicles in a manner less restrictive than 13 14 as provided in this Section. This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois 15 16 Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule units of 17 powers and functions exercised by the State.

Section 10. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 19 10-20.46 and 34-18.37 as follows:
