A municipality shall require that all vehicles purchased or leased on or after the 8 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General 9 10 Assembly for use by the municipality have a Vehicle 11 Identification Number that begins with the number one, the number 4, or the number 5. A municipality may not regulate the 12

purchase or lease of vehicles in a manner less restrictive than

as provided in this Section. This Section is a limitation under

subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois

Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule units of
