- 12 low-pressure tires, designed with a seat or saddle for operator
- use, and handlebars or steering wheel for steering control,
- 14 except equipment such as lawnmowers.

- 16 (625 ILCS 5/1-168.8 new)
- Sec. 1-168.8. Recreational off-highway vehicle. Any
- 18 <u>motorized off-highway device designed to travel primarily</u>
- 19 off-highway, 64 inches or less in width, having a
- 20 manufacturer's dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less, traveling on
- 21 <u>4 or more non-highway tires, designed with a non-straddle seat</u>
- 22 and a steering wheel for steering control, except equipment

- Sec. 11-1427.5. Recreational off-highway vehicles. All 3
- provisions of this Code that apply to an all-terrain vehicle 4
