

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 SB2804

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/1-172

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-172

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. In a provision defining a "residence district", provides that for purposes of establishing maximum speed limits, a residence district shall be at least a quarter of a mile long with residences or residences and buildings in use for businesses spaced no more than 500 feet (instead of 300 feet) apart. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 1-172 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/1-172) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-172)
- 7 Sec. 1-172. Residence district. The territory contiguous
- 8 to and including a highway not comprising a business district
- 9 when the property on such highway for a distance of 300 feet or
- 10 more is in the main improved with residences or residences and
- 11 buildings in use for business.
- 12 For purposes of establishing maximum speed limits, a
- 13 residence district shall be at least a quarter of a mile long
- 14 with residences or residences and buildings in use for
- businesses spaced no more than 500 feet apart.

- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 18 becoming law.
