## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 4-9 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/4-9) (from Ch. 38, par. 4-9)
- 7 Sec. 4-9. Absolute liability.
- 8 A person may be guilty of an offense without having, as to
- 9 each element thereof, one of the mental states described in
- 10 Sections 4--4 through 4--7 if the offense is a misdemeanor
- 11 which is not punishable by incarceration or by a fine exceeding
- 12 \$1,000 \$500, or the statute defining the offense clearly
- indicates a legislative purpose to impose absolute liability
- 14 for the conduct described.
