2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 3091 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Snowmobile Registration and Safety Act is
5	amended by changing Sections 3-1, 3-2, 3-5, 3-8, 3-11, and 9-2
6	and by adding Sections 3-12 and 3-13 as follows:
7	(625 ILCS 40/3-1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 603-1)
8	Sec. 3-1. Operation of Unnumbered Snowmobiles.
9	<u>(a)</u> Except as hereinafter provided, no person <u>who is a</u>
10	resident of this State shall, after the effective date of this
11	Act, operate any snowmobile within this State unless such
12	snowmobile has been registered and numbered in accordance with
13	the provisions of this Article, and unless (1) the certificate
14	of number awarded to such snowmobile is in full force and
15	effect. A person who is not a resident of this State and who
16	operates a snowmobile within this State may register that

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1	snowmobile in this State, but in the event that he or she does
2	not, and he or she is not otherwise exempt under subsection (c)
3	of Section 3-12 of this Article, he or she must obtain and
4	display a trail use sticker in accordance with Section 3-12 of
5	this Article.
6	(b) A person convicted of violating this Section is guilty
7	of a petty offense.

10	Sec. 3-2. Identification Number Application. The owner of
11	each snowmobile requiring numbering by this State shall file an
12	application for number with the Department on forms approved by
13	it. The application shall be signed by the owner of the
14	snowmobile and shall be accompanied by a fee of $\frac{\$30}{\$18}$ . When a
15	snowmobile dealer sells a snowmobile the dealer shall, at the
16	time of sale, require the buyer to complete an application for
17	the registration certificate, collect the required fee and mail
18	the application and fee to the Department no later than 14 days
19	after the date of sale. Combination application-receipt forms

after the date of sale. Combination application-receipt forms shall be provided by the Department and the dealer shall furnish the buyer with the completed receipt showing that application for registration has been made. This completed receipt shall be in the possession of the user of the snowmobile until the registration certificate is received. 1 performing this service required under this subsection. However, no purchaser exempted under Section 3-11 of this Act 2 3 shall be charged any fee or be subject to the other 4 requirements of this Section. The application form shall so 5 state in clear language the requirements of this Section and 6 the penalty for violation near the place on the application form provided for indicating the intention to register in 7 8 another jurisdiction. Each dealer shall maintain, for one year, 9 a record in a form prescribed by the Department for each 10 snowmobile sold. These records shall be open to inspection by 11 the Department. Upon receipt of the application in approved form the Department shall enter the same upon the records of 12 13 its office and issue to the applicant a certificate of number 14 stating the number awarded to the snowmobile and the name and 15 address of the owner.

For the registration years beginning on or after January 1, 2017, the application shall be signed by the owner of the snowmobile and shall be accompanied by a fee of \$45.

Sec. 3-5. Transfer of Identification Number. The purchaser of a snowmobile shall, within 15 days after acquiring same, make application to the Department for the transfer to him of the certificate of number issued to the snowmobile, giving his name, his address and the number of the snowmobile. 1 purchaser shall apply for a transfer-renewal for a fee of \$30 \$18 for approximately 3 years. All transfers will bear 2 3 September 30 expiration dates in the calendar year of 4 expiration. Upon receipt of the application and fee, the 5 Department shall transfer the certificate of number issued to 6 the snowmobile to the new owner. Unless the application is made and fee paid within 30 days, the snowmobile shall be deemed to 7 be without certificate of number and it shall be unlawful for 8 any person to operate the snowmobile until the certificate is 9 10 issued.

Sec. 3-8. Certificate of Number. Every certificate of 16 number awarded under this Act shall continue in full force and 17 effect for approximately 3 years unless sooner terminated or 18 19 discontinued in accordance with this Act. All new certificates 20 issued will bear September 30 expiration dates in the calendar 21 year 3 years after the issuing date. Provided however, that the 22 Department may, for purposes of implementing this Section, 23 adopt rules for phasing in the issuance of new certificates and 24 provide for 1, 2 or 3 year expiration dates and pro-rated 25 payments or charges for each registration.

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All certificates shall be renewed for 3 years from the nearest September 30 for a fee of <u>\$30</u> <del>\$18</del>. All certificates will be considered invalid after October 15 of the year of expiration. All certificates expiring in a given year shall be renewed between April 1 and September 30 of that year, in order to allow sufficient time for processing.

Department shall issue "registration expiration 7 The decals" with all new certificates of number, all certificates 8 of number transferred and renewed, and all certificates of 9 10 number renewed. The decals issued for each year shall be of a 11 different and distinct color from the decals of each year currently displayed. The decals shall be affixed to each side 12 13 of the cowling of the snowmobile in the manner prescribed by 14 the rules and regulations of the Department. The Department 15 shall fix a day and month of the year on which certificates of 16 number due to expire shall lapse and no longer be of any force and effect unless renewed pursuant to this Act. 17

No number or registration expiration decal, except a 18 19 sticker or number which may be required by a political subdivision, municipality, or state, other 20 than the 21 registration expiration decal issued to a snowmobile or granted 22 reciprocity pursuant to this Act, shall be painted, attached, 23 or otherwise displayed on either side of the cowling of such 24 snowmobile.

1 application to the Department upon forms prescribed by it, may 2 obtain certificates of number for use in the testing or 3 demonstrating of such snowmobiles upon payment of \$30 <del>\$18</del> for 4 each registration. Certificates of number so issued may be used 5 by the applicant in the testing or demonstrating of snowmobiles by temporary placement of the registration expiration decals 6 assigned by such certificates on the snowmobile so tested or 7 8 demonstrated.

14 Sec. 3-11. Exception from numbering provisions of this 15 Act.) A snowmobile shall not be required to be numbered under 16 this Act if it is:

A. Owned and used by the United States, another state, or a political subdivision thereof, but such snowmobiles shall display the name of the owner on the cowling thereof.

B. <u>(Blank).</u> Covered by a valid registration or license of another state, province or country which is the domicile of the owner of the snowmobile and is not operated within this State on more than 30 consecutive days in any calendar year.

1 than as a member of a club or association, provided the snowmobile is not operated elsewhere within the state. 2 D. Owned by persons domiciled in Illinois but used entirely 8 9 in another jurisdiction when such owner has complied with the 10 provisions of Section 3-2 of this Act. 11 F. Trail use stickers. 16 (a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this Section, a 17 18 person who is not a resident of this State shall not operate a 19 snowmobile in this State unless a numbered trail use sticker

21 (b) The fee for a trail use sticker issued for a snowmobile 22 under subsection (a) of this Section is \$25 per registration 23 year. A trail use sticker issued for such a snowmobile may be 24 issued only by the Department and persons appointed by the 25 Department and expires on June 30 of each registration year.

7	employee of the Department as the Department's agent to issue
8	trail use stickers and collect the fees for the stickers.
9	(e) The Department shall establish by rule procedures for
10	issuing trail use stickers, and the Department may promulgate
11	rules regulating the activities of persons who are authorized
12	to be agents under this Section.

14	Sec. 3-13. Mandatory liability insurance.
15	(a) Other than a person operating a snowmobile on their own
16	property, no person shall operate, register, or maintain
17	registration of, and no owner shall permit another person to
18	operate, register or maintain registration of, a snowmobile in
19	this State unless the snowmobile is covered by a liability
20	insurance policy.
21	The insurance policy shall be issued in amounts no less
22	than the minimum amounts set for bodily injury or death and for
23	destruction of property under Section 7-203 of the Illinois
24	Vehicle Code, and shall be issued in accordance with the
25	requirements of Sections 143a and 143a-2 of the Illinois

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1	Insurance Code, as amended. No insurer other than an insurer
2	authorized to do business in this State shall issue a policy
3	pursuant to this Section for any snowmobile subject to
4	registration and numbering under this Act. Nothing herein shall
5	deprive an insurer of any policy defense available at common
6	law.
7	(b) Proof of insurance as required by this Section shall be
8	produced and displayed by the owner or operator of the
9	snowmobile upon request to any law enforcement officer or to
10	any person who has suffered or claims to have suffered either
11	personal injury or property damage as a result of the operation
12	of the snowmobile by the owner or operator.
13	(c) Except as provided in subsection (d), any operator of a
14	snowmobile subject to registration and numbering under this Act
15	who is convicted of violating subsection (a) of this Section is
16	guilty of a petty offense. However, no person charged with
17	violating this Section shall be convicted if such person
18	produces in court satisfactory evidence that at the time of the
19	arrest the snowmobile was covered by a liability insurance
20	policy in accordance with subsection (a) of this Section. The
21	chief judge of each circuit may designate an officer of the
22	court to review the documentation demonstrating that at the
23	time of arrest the snowmobile was covered by a liability
24	insurance policy in accordance with subsection (a) of this
25	Section.
26	(d) A person who (i) has not previously been convicted of

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1 or received a disposition of court supervision for violating subsection (a) of this Section and (ii) produces at his or her 2 3 court appearance satisfactory evidence that the snowmobile is 4 covered, as of the date of the court appearance, by a liability 5 insurance policy in accordance with Section 7-601 of the Illinois Vehicle Code shall, for a violation of this Section, 6 pay a fine of \$100 and receive a disposition of court 7 supervision. The person must, on the date that the period of 8 9 court supervision is scheduled to terminate, produce 10 satisfactory evidence that the snowmobile was covered by the 11 required liability insurance policy during the entire period of 12 court supervision.

13 An officer of the court designated under subsection (c) may 14 also review liability insurance documentation under this 15 subsection (d) to determine if the snowmobile is, as of the 16 date of the court appearance, covered by a liability insurance policy in accordance with Section 7-601 of the Illinois Vehicle 17 Code. The officer of the court shall also determine, on the 18 19 date the period of court supervision is scheduled to terminate, 20 whether the snowmobile was covered by the required policy 21 during the entire period of court supervision.

23 Sec. 9-2. Special fund. There is created a special fund in 24 the State Treasury to be known as the Snowmobile Trail 25 Establishment Fund. <u>Fifty</u> Thirty three percent of each new, 09600SB3091sam001 -11- LRB096 16332 AJT 37557 a

1 transfer-renewal, and renewal registration, and trail use sticker fee collected under Sections 3-2, 3-5, and 3-8, and 2 3 3-12 of this Act shall be deposited in the fund. The fund shall 4 be administered by the Department and shall be used for 5 disbursement, upon written application to and subsequent 6 approval by the Department, to nonprofit snowmobile clubs and for construction, 7 organizations maintenance. and rehabilitation of snowmobile trails and areas for the use of 8 9 snowmobiles, including plans and specifications, engineering 10 surveys and supervision where necessary. The Department shall 11 promulgate such rules or regulations as it deems necessary for administration of The Snowmobile Trail 12 the the fund. 13 Establishment Fund shall not be subject to sweeps, 14 administrative charges or chargebacks, such as but not limited 15 to those authorized under Section 8h of the State Finance Act, 16 or any other fiscal or budgetary maneuver that would in any way result in the transfer of any funds from the Snowmobile Trail 17 Establishment Fund to any other fund of the State. 18
