Sec. 6z-77. The Capital Projects Fund. The Capital Projects 9 10 Fund is created as a special fund in the State Treasury. The State Comptroller and State Treasurer shall transfer from the 11 12 Capital Projects Fund to the General Revenue Fund \$61,294,550 13 on October 1, 2009, \$122,589,100 on January 1, 2010, and \$61,294,550 on April 1, 2010. Beginning on July 1, 2010, and on 14 15 July 1 and January 1 of each year thereafter, the State Comptroller and State Treasurer shall transfer the sum of 16

- 1 \$122,589,100 from the Capital Projects Fund to the General
- 2 Revenue Fund. Subject to appropriation, the Capital Projects
- Fund may be used only for capital projects and the payment of 3
- 4 debt service on bonds issued for capital projects. If moneys
- 5 have been deposited into the Fund pursuant to Section 7.6, 12,
- 6 or 13 of the Riverboat Gambling Act that are not necessary for
- the purposes of the Fund, as determined jointly by the State 7
- Treasurer and State Comptroller, then, on at least an annual 8
- 9 basis, the State Comptroller shall order and the State
- 10 Treasurer shall transfer that excess amount from the Fund to
- 11 the Education Assistance Fund. All interest earned on moneys in
- the Fund shall be deposited into the Fund. The Fund shall not 12
- 13 be subject to administrative charges or chargebacks, such as
- but not limited to those authorized under Section 8h. 14
