2 on page 8, line 5, after the period, by inserting the 3 following: 4 "However, if the all-terrain vehicle or recreational off-highway vehicle, as used in this Section, is not covered 5 under a motor vehicle insurance policy pursuant to subsection 6 7 (h) of Section 11-1605 of this Code, the vehicle must be 8 covered under a farm, home, or non-highway vehicle insurance 9 policy issued with coverage amounts no less than the minimum amounts set for bodily injury or death and for destruction of 10 property under Section 7-203 of this Code. All-terrain or 11 recreational off-highway vehicles operated on a county or 12 township roadway at any time between one-half hour before 13 14 sunset and one-half hour after sunrise must be equipped with head lamps and tail lamps, and the head lamps and tail lamps 15 16 must be lighted."; and
