1 departments, agencies, boards, members of State and 2 commissions whose annual compensation was recommended or determined by the Compensation Review Board, are prohibited 3 4 from receiving and shall not receive any increase in 5 compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of 6 living adjustment, as authorized by Senate Joint Resolution 192 of the 86th General Assembly, for or during the fiscal year 7 beginning July 1, 2009. That cost of living adjustment shall 8 9 apply again in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010 and 10 thereafter.
