## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Critical Health Problems and Comprehensive
- 5 Health Education Act is amended by adding Section 3.5 as
- 6 follows:

- 8 Sec. 3.5. Nutrition and physical activity best practices
- 9 <u>database</u>.
- 10 <u>(a) The State Board of Education shall develop and maintain</u>
- 11 <u>a nutrition and physical activity best practices database. The</u>
- 12 <u>database shall contain the results of any wellness-related</u>
- fitness testing done by local school districts, as well as
- 14 <u>information on successful programs and policies implemented by</u>
- 15 <u>local school districts designed to improve nutrition and</u>
- 16 physical activity in the public and charter schools. This
- information may include (i) a description of the program or
- policy, (ii) advice on implementation, (iii) any assessment of
- 19 the program or policy, (iv) a contact person from the local
- 20 school district, and (v) any other information the State Board
- of Education deems appropriate. The database shall be readily
- 22 <u>accessible to all local school districts Statewide. The State</u>
- 23 Board of Education shall encourage local school districts to

- 1 submit information to the database, however no school district
- 2 shall be required to submit information.
- 3 (b) The State Board of Education may adopt rules necessary
- 4 for administration of this Section.
- (c) The requirements of the State Board of Education to 5
- 6 establish this database shall become effective once the State
- 7 Board of Education has secured all of the funding necessary to
- 8 implement it.
