1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
7 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Labor:

14 Section 20. In addition to any other funds appropriated
 15 for that purpose, the sum of \$81,100 is appropriated from the
 16 General Revenue Fund to the Department of Labor for all costs
 17 associated with promoting and enforcing the Equal Pay Act and
 18 the Victims Economic Security and Safety Act.

19 Section 25. The amount of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of
 21 Labor Federal Trust Fund to the Department of Labor for all
 22 costs associated with promoting and enforcing the
 23 occupational safety and health administration state program

1 for public sector worksites.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
3 2010.
