- Section 15. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois
 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call
 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground
 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.
- Section 20. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for refunds.
- Section 25. The sum of \$64,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission

- 3 the Department of State Police for the design,

13 Section 40. The sum of \$4,450,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 14 15 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 16 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration 17 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) 18 19 administrative expenses.

Section 45. The sum of \$24,700, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 21 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for 22 railroad crossing improvement initiatives. 23
