2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of William Thomas "Bill" Ames of Barrington, 4 who passed away on May 26, 2009; and

5 WHEREAS, He was born July 4, 1925, in Plainfield, New 6 Jersey; he grew up in Niagara Falls, New York, and was the son 7 of Oliver B. and Linda Hill Ames; in his younger days his 8 nickname was Dick, and he had a love for big band music and was 9 an avid saxophone player and had a band of his own; and

10 WHEREAS, He served three years in the United States Navy from 1943 to 1946; he sailed on the McCoy Reynolds DE-440 and 11 12 was part of the crew's Sonar unit; along with his crew members, 13 he helped his ship survive both a typhoon and a kamikaze 14 after graduating with a degree strike; in industrial engineering from the University of Buffalo, he married the love 15 of his life, Evelyn Zobel on July 26, 1952; and 16

17 WHEREAS, He worked in Chicago after moving to Illinois, and 18 walked to the train station every day as part of his commute; 19 he retired from Industrial Risk Insurers in 1987 and remained 20 active in the community; he was a mainstay at the Barrington 21 Historical Society, acting as building and grounds chairman, 22 and taught a safe driving course held in Cuba Township; and -2- LRB096 13343 KXB 28043 r
