2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Dr. David Arnold Frier Jr. of 4 Springfield, who passed away on February 27, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, He was a member of the Illinois Prisoner Review 6 Board and served under two governors; he was born in Benton in 7 1931; and

8 WHEREAS, He received bachelor's, master's, and doctoral 9 degrees from Southern Illinois University at Carbondale; he was 10 a tenured professor at Western Illinois University, where he 11 taught political science for 20 years; a number of his 12 students, including Mary Matalin and Senator Kirk Dillard, went 13 on to political careers; and

14 WHEREAS, He was also a noted antique dealer and collector 15 and for many years had a shop in Macomb, as well as exhibiting 16 at shows around the Midwest; he was known for painting Illinois 17 River duck decoys, which are widely sold at shows across the 18 United States and on eBay; and
