2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Howard W. Robertson of Highland, who 4 passed away on April 12, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, He was born August 26, 1934, in Springfield, 6 Missouri; he graduated from Granite City High School in 1952; 7 he received a full football scholarship to the University of 8 Missouri, where he played all four years; he was also a member 9 of the ROTC and graduated with a BS in agriculture; and

10 WHEREAS, He entered the United States Army as a second 11 lieutenant; he served with the First Artillery Division (Big 12 Red One); he and his wife moved to Highland in 1959, where he 13 opened The Howard Robertson State Farm Agency, which is still 14 operating in Highland; he was a member of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity, the University of Missouri Alumni Association and 15 many organizations in Highland; for years, he was a member of 16 the football chain gang at every Highland football game; and 17

18 WHEREAS, He and his wife traveled extensively, to every 19 continent, enjoyed motorhome travel, had a winter home in Gulf 20 Shores, Alabama, and have spent winter time in Sarasota, 21 Florida; and
