WHEREAS, He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Hillsboro, Mt. Moriah Masonic Lodge #51 AF & AM in Hillsboro, V.F.W. Post #1306 in Taylor Springs, and Hillsboro Moose Lodge #1377; he was a veteran of World War II with the Army Air Corp from 1943 to 1945; he was a B17 gunner who served in Normandy, Northern France Ardennes, Rhineland; he earned 4 Bronze Stars, a Good Conduct Air Medal, 3 Bronze Clusters, and 1 O/s Bar; and
