2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 137 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5	10-20.53 and 34-18.45 as follows:
6	(105 ILCS 5/10-20.53 new)
7	<u>Sec. 10-20.53. Trans fat ban.</u>
8	(a) For the purposes of this Section:
9	"Individually packaged food item" means a food item in the
10	manufacturer's original, sealed package.
11	"Trans fat" means fat that is considered trans fat by the
12	U.S. Food and Drug Administration. "Trans fat" does not include
13	naturally occurring trans fat. Food shall be deemed to contain
14	trans fat under this Section if the food is labeled as, lists
15	as an ingredient, or contains any kind of partially
16	hydrogenated vegetable oil, including without limitation

1	vegetable shortening or margarine. However, food shall not be
2	deemed to contain trans fat under this Section if the food
3	contains less than 0.5 grams of trans fat per serving.
4	(b) Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, a school
5	board shall prohibit schools from selling or serving any
6	individually packaged food item that contains trans fat in a
7	vending machine, a la carte, or as part of the school breakfast
8	program, the school lunch program, or the summer food service
9	program. Each school shall certify compliance with this Section
10	in writing to the president of the school board, and this
11	certification must be read into the record at the next
12	regularly scheduled board meeting after receipt of the
13	certification.
14	(c) This Section does not apply to individually packaged
15	food items sold or served by students off-campus as part of a
16	fundraiser or to fundraisers that take place on campus by
17	groups that are not associated with the school.

19	Sec. 34-18.45. Trans fat ban.
20	(a) For the purposes of this Section:
21	"Individually packaged food item" means a food item in the
22	manufacturer's original, sealed package.
23	"Trans fat" means fat that is considered trans fat by the
24	U.S. Food and Drug Administration. "Trans fat" does not include

25 <u>naturally occurring trans fat. Food shall be deemed to contain</u>

1 trans fat under this Section if the food is labeled as, lists
2 as an ingredient, or contains any kind of partially
3 hydrogenated vegetable oil, including without limitation
4 vegetable shortening or margarine. However, food shall not be
5 deemed to contain trans fat under this Section if the food
6 contains less than 0.5 grams of trans fat per serving.

(b) Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, the board 7 shall prohibit schools from selling or serving any individually 8 9 packaged food item that contains trans fat in a vending 10 machine, a la carte, or as part of the school breakfast program, the school lunch program, or the summer food service 11 program. Each school shall certify compliance with this Section 12 in writing to the president of the board, and this 13 14 certification must be read into the record at the next 15 regularly scheduled board meeting after receipt of the 16 certification.

17 (c) This Section does not apply to individually packaged 18 food items sold or served by students off-campus as part of a 19 fundraiser or to fundraisers that take place on campus by 20 groups that are not associated with the school.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22 becoming law.".
