Amends the Illinois Highway Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning damage to sidewalks, bridges, culverts, or causeways.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 9-122 as follows:
- 6 (605 ILCS 5/9-122) (from Ch. 121, par. 9-122)
- 7 Sec. 9-122. If any person purposely destroys or injures any
- 8 sidewalk, public bridge, culvert, or causeway, or removes any
- 9 of $\underline{\text{the}}$ timber or plank thereof, or obstructs the same, he
- shall be guilty of a petty offense, fined not more than \$100,
- and shall be liable for all damages occasioned thereby and all
- 12 necessary costs for rebuilding or repairing the same.
