AN ACT concerning business.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Credit Card Issuance Act is amended by 5 changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 140/1) (from Ch. 17, par. 6001)

Sec. 1. As used in this Act: (a) "Credit card" has the the 7 meaning set forth in Section 2.03 of the Illinois Credit Card 8 9 and Debit Card Act, but does not include "debit card" as defined in Section 2.15 of the Illinois Credit Card and Debit 10 Card Act, which can also be used to obtain money, goods, 11 services and anything else of value on credit, nor shall it 12 include any negotiable instrument as defined in the Uniform 13 14 Commercial Code, as now or hereafter amended; (b) "merchant credit card agreement" means a written agreement between a 15 seller of goods, services or both, and the issuer of a credit 16 17 card to any other party, pursuant to which the seller is obligated to accept credit cards; and (c) "credit card 18 19 transaction" means a purchase and sale of goods, services or both, in which a seller, pursuant to a merchant credit card 20 21 agreement, is obligated to accept a credit card and does accept 22 the credit card in connection with such purchase and sale.
