AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Surface-Mined Land Conservation and 5 Reclamation Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 715/2) (from Ch. 96 1/2, par. 4502)

7 Sec. 2. Statement of policy. It is declared to be the the 8 policy of this State to provide for conservation and 9 reclamation of lands affected by surface mining in order to restore them to optimum future productive use and to provide 10 for their return to productive use including but not limited 11 to: the planting of forests; the seeding of grasses and legumes 12 for grazing purposes; the planting of crops for harvest; the 13 14 enhancement. of wildlife aquatic and resources; the establishment of recreational, residential and industrial 15 sites; and for the conservation, development, management, and 16 17 appropriate use of all the natural resources of such areas for compatible multiple purposes, to aid in maintaining or 18 19 improving the tax base; and protecting the health, safety and 20 general welfare of the people, the natural beauty and aesthetic 21 values, and enhancement of the environment in the affected 22 areas of the State; to prevent erosion, stream pollution, water, air and land pollution and other injurious effects to 23

persons, property, wildlife and natural resources; and to 1 2 assure that conservation and reclamation plans for all surface mining activity are available for the prior consideration of 3 4 county governments within whose jurisdiction such lands will be 5 affected by surface mining and to permit participation and 6 authorize cooperation and coordination with the federal government in initial regulatory programs under the federal 7 Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977, Public Law 8 9 95-87, Title 30, USC Sec. 1201 et seq.

10 The issuance of a permit under this Act to engage in the 11 surface mining of any resources other than fossil fuels is not 12 intended to relieve the permittee from its duty to comply with 13 other applicable state and local law regulating the 14 commencement, location and operation of surface mining 15 facilities.
