A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet  
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending  
10 June 30, 2012:

11	For Personal Services .....	2,238,800
12	For State Contributions to Social	
13	Security, for Medicare .....	32,000
14	For Contractual Services .....	568,500
15	For Travel .....	60,000
16	For Commodities .....	11,200
17	For Printing .....	10,000
18	For Equipment .....	16,500
19	For Telecommunications .....	35,000
20	For Operation of Automotive Equipment .....	<u>4,000</u>
21	Total	\$2,976,000

1 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much  
 2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
 3 Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for  
 4 distribution as grants authorized by the Higher Education  
 5 Cooperation Act:

6 Quad-Cities Graduate Study Center .....130,000

7 Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 8 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General  
 9 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for  
 10 Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (S.T.E.M.)  
 11 diversity initiatives to enhance S.T.E.M. programs for  
 12 students from underrepresented groups:

13 Chicago Area Health and Medical  
 14 Careers Program (C.A.H.M.C.P.) .....531,000  
 15 Illinois Mathematics and Science  
 16 Academy Excellence 2000 Program  
 17 in Mathematics and Science .....59,000  
 18 Total \$590,000

19 Section 20. The sum of \$1,716,000, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 21 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the  
 22 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for

1 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

2 Section 25. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants  
4 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under  
5 the terms and conditions associated with the federal  
6 contracts and grants moneys received.

7 Section 30. The sum of \$1,640,000, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
9 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration  
10 and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying  
11 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

12 Section 35. The sum of \$1,230,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
14 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as  
15 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of  
16 higher education.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$880,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
19 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants  
20 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating  
21 nurses.

1           Section 45. The sum of \$180,000, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3           Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator  
4           fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

5           Section 50. The sum of \$230,000, or so much thereof as  
6           may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7           Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated  
8           with the u.Select System.

9           Section 55. The sum of \$205,000, or so much thereof as  
10          may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
11          Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated  
12          with the Integrated P-20 Student Information System.

13          Section 60. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as  
14          may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College  
15          Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher  
16          Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses  
17          associated with the administration and enforcement of 110  
18          ILCS 1005.

19          Section 65. The amount of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may  
20          be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality

1 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as  
 2 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with  
 3 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

4 Section 70. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as  
 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 6 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the Grow  
 7 Your Own Teachers Program.

9 Section 75. The following named amounts, or so much  
 10 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
 11 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
 12 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and  
 13 Science Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for  
 14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012:

15	For Personal Services .....	12,328,530
16	For State Contributions to Social	
17	Security, for Medicare .....	178,870
18	For Contractual Services .....	4,297,000
19	For Travel .....	144,000
20	For Commodities .....	381,000

7 fiscal year ending June 30, 2012:
