## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 5. 5 The following named amounts, or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board 8 9 for ordinary and contingent expenses: 10 For State Contributions to Social 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19

Section 10. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 1 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois 3 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and 4

conditions associated with the moneys being received.

- Section 15. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as 6 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult 8 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for operational expenses associated with administration of adult 9 10 education and literacy activities.

- 18 Section 60. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as

- Section 65. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as 1
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE GED Testing
- Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs 3
- associated with administering GED tests. 4
- Section 70. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as 5
- 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instruction
- 7 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to
- 8 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
- 9 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.
- 10 Section 75. The sum of \$7,261,500, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 11
- 12 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse
- 13 colleges up to 50 percent of the costs associated with the
- 14 Illinois Veterans' Grant.
- Section 80. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 15
- 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 17 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
- 18 associated with the College and Career Readiness Pilot
- 19 Program.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
