A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
7 General Revenue Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy
8 Commission for the purposes hereinafter named:

9	For Personal Services	9,161,200
10	For State Contributions to	
11	Social Security	699,900
12	For Contractual Services	354,200
13	For Travel	175,000
14	For Commodities	11,700
15	For Printing	13,000
16	For Equipment	26,000
17	For Electronic Data Processing	45,500
18	For Telecommunications Services	277,600
19	For Operation of Auto Equipment	<u>15,000</u>
20	Total	\$10,779,100

1 Section 10. The sum of \$187,700, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Guardianship and
3 Advocacy Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for
4 services pursuant to Section 5 of the Guardianship and
5 Advocacy Act.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
