Amends the Illinois Fire Protection Training Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning a legislative declaration.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Fire Protection Training Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 740/1) (from Ch. 85, par. 531)
- 7 Sec. 1. Legislative Declaration. It is declared as a $\frac{1}{2}$ matter of legislative determination that in order to promote 8 9 and protect the health, safety and welfare of the public, it is 10 necessary and in the public interest to provide for the encouraging and aiding of municipalities, counties and other 11 local governmental agencies of this State in their efforts to 12 raise the level of local fire protection by upgrading and 13 14 maintaining a high level of training for fire protection personnel. It is declared to be the responsibility of the 15 16 Office of the State Fire Marshal to encourage the participation 17 of local governmental units in the programs established by the Office and to aid in the establishment of adequate training 18 19 facilities.
