A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Local Governmental and Governmental
5 Employees Tort Immunity Act is amended by changing Section
6 3-107 as follows:

7 (745 ILCS 10/3-107) (from Ch. 85, par. 3-107)

8 Sec. 3-107. Neither a local public entity nor ~~nor~~ a public
9 employee is liable for an injury caused by a condition of: (a)
10 Any road which provides access to fishing, hunting, or
11 primitive camping, recreational, or scenic areas and which is
12 not a (1) city, town or village street (2) county, state or
13 federal highway or (3) a township or other road district
14 highway. (b) Any hiking, riding, fishing or hunting trail.
