

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB3015

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 320/4 new

Amends the Public Safety Employee Benefits Act. Provides the health benefits of that Act to a person who is employed as a security guard by the State on a full-time, part-time, temporary, or contractual-payroll basis and whose death or catastrophic injury in the line of duty occurs on or after September 1, 2011. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Safety Employee Benefits Act is amended by adding Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 320/4 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 4. State security guards.</u>
- 8 (a) A person who is employed as a security guard by the
- 9 State on a full-time, part-time, temporary, or
- 10 <u>contractual-payroll basis and who suffers a catastrophic</u>
- 11 <u>injury or is killed in the line of duty on or after September</u>
- 12 <u>1, 2011 under circumstances described in subsection (b) of</u>
- 13 Section 10 is entitled to the benefits provided in that
- 14 <u>Section, notwithstanding the "full-time" requirement of</u>
- subsection (a) of that Section.
- 16 (b) As used in this Section, "State" means the State of
- 17 Illinois or any of its departments, divisions, boards, bureaus,
- commissions, authorities, colleges, and universities.
- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.
