2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing
Section 19-135 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 5/19-135)

7 Sec. 19-135. Single billing. It is the intent of the 8 General Assembly that in any service area where customers are 9 able to choose their natural gas supplier, a single billing option shall be offered to customers for both the services 10 provided by the alternative gas supplier and the delivery 11 services provided by the gas utility. A gas utility shall file 12 a tariff pursuant to Article IX of this Act that allows 13 14 alternative gas suppliers to issue single bills to residential and small commercial customers for both the services provided 15 16 by the alternative gas supplier and the delivery services 17 provided by the gas utility to customers; provided that if a form of single billing is being offered in a gas utility's 18 19 service area on August 26, 2002, then the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly, that form of 20 21 single billing shall remain in effect unless and until 22 otherwise ordered by the Commission.
