AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3127

AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3127 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

"Section 5. The Sanitary District Act of 1936 is amended by adding Section 3.05 as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 2805/3.05 new)

Sec. 3.05. Five-member board. Any appointed board of trustees of a sanitary district may, by ordinance, provide for the establishment of a 5-member board of trustees. When such an ordinance has been adopted, the appropriate appointing authority shall, within 60 days after the date of the adoption of the ordinance, appoint 2 additional trustees to the board of trustees, one to hold office for 2 years and one to hold office for 3 years from the first Monday of May next after their appointment and until their successors are appointed and have qualified. The terms of these 2 additional members shall be

- 1 determined by lot at the first meeting of the board of trustees 2 held after the 2 additional members take office. The 3 trustees 3 already holding office in the sanitary district shall continue 4 to hold office for the remainder of their respective terms. 5 Thereafter, on or before the second Monday in April of each year the appropriate appointing authority shall appoint one 6 trustee or 2 trustees, as shall be necessary to maintain a 7 5-member board of trustees, whose terms shall be for 3 years 8 9 commencing the first Monday in May of the year in which they 10 are respectively appointed.
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 12 becoming law.".
