| 5  | (b) A person may not ride a bicycle on a roadway, sidewalk,    |

| 7  | to compose, send, or read an electronic message.               |
| 8  | (c) This Section does not apply to:                            |
| 9  | (1) a law enforcement officer while performing his or          |
| 10 | her official duties;   |
| 11 | (2) a bicyclist using an electronic communication              |
| 12 | device for the sole purpose of reporting an emergency          |
| 13 | situation and continued communication with emergency           |
| 14 | personnel during the emergency situation;                      |
| 15 | (3) a bicyclist using an electronic communication              |
| 16 | device in hands-free or voice-activated mode; or               |
| 17 | (4) a bicyclist using an electronic communication              |
| 18 | device while stopped on the shoulder of a roadway.".           |
