SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/5-137.1 new 30 ILCS 805/8.36 new

Amends the Chicago Police Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Provides for payment of a widow's annuity to an individual engaged to be married to (or to be joined in a civil union with) a policeman who dies in service on or after December 1, 2011. Requires a person making a claim for this benefit to produce clear and convincing evidence at a hearing before the Board that he or she was actually engaged to the policeman at the time of the policeman's death. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding Section 5-137.1 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/5-137.1 new)

December 1, 2011.

- Sec. 5-137.1. Widow's annuity Death in service Engaged

 person. The annuity benefits set forth in Section 5-137 for

 widows shall also apply to an individual who is engaged to be

 married to (or to be joined in a civil union with) a present

 employee or future entrant who dies in service on or after
- A person making a claim for benefits under this Section 13 14 must produce clear and convincing evidence at a hearing before the Board that he or she was actually engaged to be married to 15 16 (or to be joined in a civil union with) the policeman at the 17 time of the policeman's death. The limitation of subdivision (a) of Section 5-146 (requiring marriage for at least one year) 18 19 and any other provisions of this Article requiring marriage (or 20 civil union) as a condition of receiving a widow's annuity do 21 not apply to the granting of a widow's annuity to an engaged 22 person under this Section.

- 1 persons in service on or after the effective date of this
- 2 amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly.
- 3 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
- 4 Section 8.36 as follows:

- 6 Sec. 8.36. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- 8 <u>implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of</u>
- 9 the 97th General Assembly.
- 10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 11 becoming law.
