### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 505/5c

Amends the Children and Family Services Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning direct child welfare service employee licenses.

AN ACT concerning State government.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended
by changing Section 5c as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 505/5c)

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Sec. 5c. Direct child welfare service employee license.

8 (a) By January 1, 2000, the the Department, in consultation 9 with private child welfare agencies, shall develop and 10 implement a direct child welfare service employee license. By 2001 all child protective investigators and 11 January 1, 12 supervisors and child welfare specialists and supervisors 13 employed by the Department or its contractors shall be required 14 to demonstrate sufficient knowledge and skills to obtain and maintain the license. The Direct Child Welfare Service Employee 15 16 License Board of the Department shall have the authority to 17 revoke or suspend the license of anyone who after a hearing is found to be quilty of misfeasance. The Department shall 18 19 promulgate such rules as necessary to implement this Section.

20 (b) If a direct child welfare service employee licensee is 21 expected to transport a child or children with a motor vehicle 22 in the course of performing his or her duties, the Department 23 must verify that the licensee meets the requirements set forth - 2 - LRB097 18275 KTG 63501 b

1 in Section 5.1 of the Child Care Act of 1969. The Department 2 must make that verification as to each such licensee every 2 years. Upon the Department's request, the Secretary of State 3 4 shall provide the Department with the information necessary to 5 enable the Department to make the verifications required under 6 this subsection. If the Department discovers that a direct 7 child welfare service employee licensee has engaged in transporting a child or children with a motor vehicle without 8 9 having a valid driver's license, the Department shall 10 immediately revoke the individual's direct child welfare 11 service employee license.

(c) On or before January 1, 2000, and every year
thereafter, the Department shall submit an annual report to the
General Assembly on the implementation of this Section.
