1 AN ACT concerning State government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Governor Transition Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 10/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b121)

Sec. 1. When at any general election for the the office of Governor the incumbent Governor is not elected, the Governor, within 2 weeks after such election, shall provide space for not more than 5 persons designated by the Governor-elect to enable the Governor-elect to begin a review and analysis of budgeted expenditures during the then current biennium and budget requests for the ensuing biennium and to acquire a working knowledge of the various offices, departments, commissions, boards and other agencies of the executive branch of the State government. The Governor shall cooperate with Governor-elect and the staff so designated by him and provide any assistance that may be reasonably requested.
